



Don't wait to update! Talk with your doctor to make sure your child is up to date on their vaccines before school starts!

According to the Texas Administrative Code, Chapters 97.61-97.72, students must have current immunizations to attend public school. Below you will find which vaccines your child needs in order to attend school.

Prek3 & Prek 4

Texas Minimum State Vaccine Requirements include:

- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP vaccine)
- Polio (IPV vaccine)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR vaccine)
- Hepatitis B
- Chickenpox (Varicella vaccine)
- Hepatitis A
- Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib) 2
- Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV)

Kindergarten- 6th grade

Texas Minimum State Vaccine Requirements include:

- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP vaccine)
- Polio (IPV vaccine)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR vaccine)
- Hepatitis B
- Chickenpox (Varicella vaccine)
- Hepatitis A
